As I watched the program I became very disturbed when talking about the cost of immigrants. I make \$41,000.00 per year. If my wife does not want to work she does not have the work. We are letting undesirable immigrants into the United States that will be a burden on tax payers. These immigrants should have last priority, not applicants like my wife that will be no burden to anyone. I would like for her case to be looked at & sped up & her by my side where she should be anyway. You would not believe the problems & trouble I am having in sending money to my wife for her survival.

I think about my wife constantly, concerned for her safety and also about the immigration process. Did you know the process her paperwork it cost \$75.00. I wonder how many of the 20,000 per year Cuban immigrants are going to pay \$75.00 processing fee.
