WASHINGTON, D.C.-- The race for the Virginia governor's mansion is nearing the wire and C-SPAN cameras travel to Richmond for a closer look at the candidates before they face the polls.

October 20 & 21, C-SPAN continues its "States of the Nation '85" tour of state capitals with a stop in Virginia's capital city to focus on the statewide elections coming up in November.

C-SPAN's Richmond programming includes live viewer call-in shows with Gov. Charles Robb, candidates for governor and lieutenant governor, and local political journalists. The programs originate from a committee room in Virginia's historic, Jeffersonian—designed state capitol.
