I think your round table should, instead, be replaced with a round table-like desk.

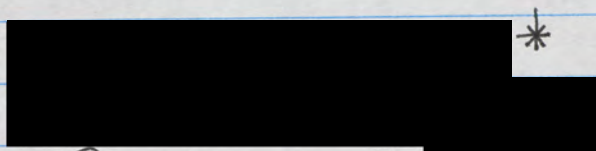
Oh yes—some of your guests even tap their feet.
