Brian, is it possible to get a videotape or recording of this 9/2/91 program? Please advise.

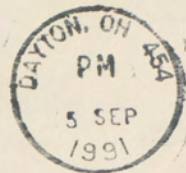
Thanks again for those unforgettable two hours. How about a Labor Day tradition with these three?

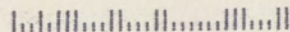
