You could have original news footage of '63, and people who have written about the assassination, including members or staff of the Warren Commission, House Select Committee on Assassinations, researchers, critics, conspiracy theorists, historians, and possibly witnesses, if there are any still alive. It would also be interesting to get some "man on the street" views of the assassination and its impact on people's lives.
