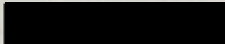
Your viewers would understand the Republican positions on various topics if they replied to the President on the subject he discusses - not anything they want to propagandize about.

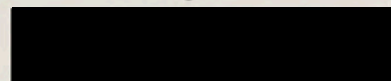
