## C-SPAN TO TELEVISION HISTORIC IMPEACHMENT PROCEEDINGS

### Preliminary Hearings Begin September 15

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- This month, C-SPAN viewers have the rare opportunity to watch the historic impeachment proceedings of Nevada Federal Judge Harry Claiborne, only the 11th impeachment trial in the history of our country and the first to be televised.

C-SPAN's impeachment coverage begins on September 15, live from 9:00 am - 12:00 pm ET, when the Senate Impeachment Committee -- chaired by Sen. Charles McC. Mathias (R-MD) -- begins hearing evidence against Judge Claiborne.
