Thanks for C-SPAN... you and your staff are doing a wonderful job of presenting issues objectively, thoroughly and without apparent bias.

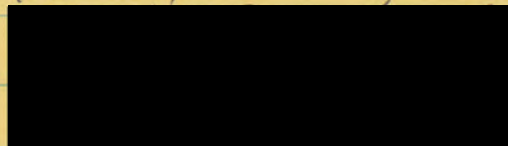

I hope these journalists know that C-SPAN audiences are by and large avid readers and watchers who in some cases know as much or more about issues than some of the "pros".

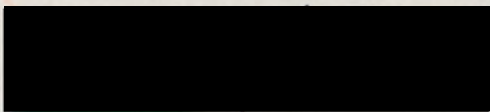
We know that the occasional lemon is an aberration and thank you for the 95% of challenging interesting and persuasive people (newsmakers, politicians, journalists) you have on the air.
