C-SPAN TELEVISES LIVE INTERVIEW WITH SENATOR DENNIS DeCONCINI

Senator to Appear During Break In Monday's "Keating Five" Hearing

Washington, D.C., November 30 -- On Monday, December 3, C-SPAN will air a live interview with Arizona Senator Dennis DeConcini (D) during the lunch break in the Senate Ethics Committee hearing on the "Keating Five."

At approximately 12:30 PM (ET), Senator DeConcini will discuss his defense at the hearings and provide insight into the testimony given in the hearings thus far.

Senator DeConcini becomes the second "Keating Five" senator to appear on C-SPAN since the ethics committee opened hearings on November 15 regarding the relationships of five senators with savings and loan executive Charles Keating. Senator John McCain (R-AZ) was featured on a C-SPAN live Viewer Call-in program on Friday, November 16.

C-SPAN has aired live every Senate Ethics Committee hearing on the "Keating Five" -- as well as gavel-to-gavel prime-time re-airs -- providing the most extensive television coverage of the savings and loan case. The network plans continued live coverage of the hearings as they head into their third week.

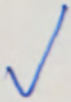
