"He" wants an outside investigative study done on this stupidly bloated (by the media, of course) thing. Bush appointed a fellow Republican as

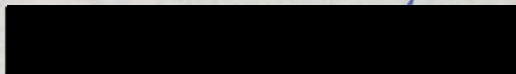
counsel to investigate his alleged

be plants.

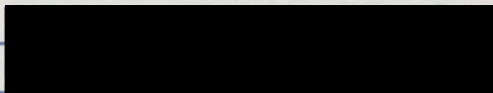
I suggest you spend less time

need to hear constant denunciation

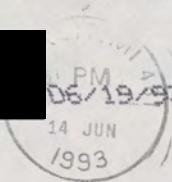
from the minority who have no intention to educate or inform. I think it is divisive to our country to provide equal time.
