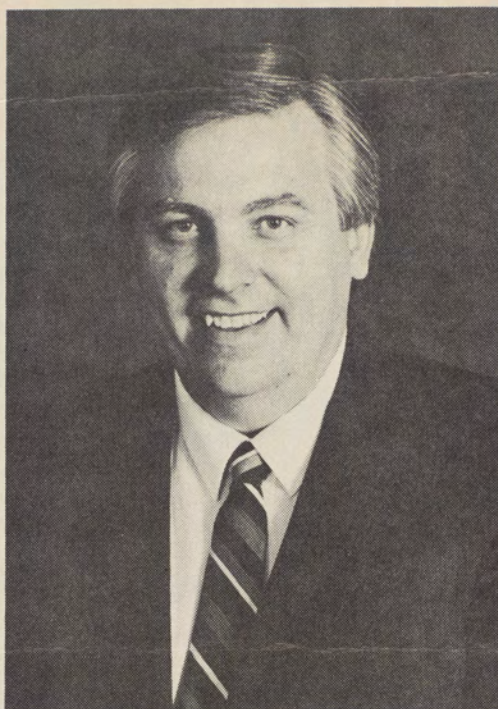

Gorbachev playing us for suckers

Which is more dumbfounding — that the Soviets have the gall to ask for massive economic assistance, or that some in the West are eager to comply?

President Bush announced that he "liked what (he) heard" from Gorbachev adviser Yevgeny Primakov, who came to Washington last week to supplicate. Our European allies, meanwhile, are pressing Bush to agree to invite Gorbachev to the next economic summit meeting, and to offer him membership in the International Monetary Fund.

MONEY FOR REFORM

Just how much the Soviets are asking for is not quite clear. Mikhail Gorbachev allowed the number \$100 billion to fall promiscuously from his lips last week, but then vehemently denied that he was begging for that amount. We've already agreed to \$1.5 billion in grain credits, and there is now talk of \$30 or \$40 billion per year over five years in exchange for Soviet promises of reform.

Pardon me, but has everyone gone absolutely nuts?

There are about a million reasons why we shouldn't give the Soviets a dime, but let me start with 140 of them. That's the number of new intercontinental ballistic missiles the Soviets produced in 1989. They also produced 1,300 sea-launched cruise missiles, 1,500 artillery pieces and 5,700 armored fighting vehicles. If we give aid to the Soviets, we remove the incentive for them to reduce their massive military spending, which currently exceeds 25 percent of their gross national product.

Besides, the Soviets are not without considerable resources. The Soviet Union is not a poor country, it simply makes poor decisions.

As Bruce Porter reports in the *National Interest* magazine, the CIA estimates that the gold and diamond reserves in the Soviet Union are worth about \$34 billion. The Soviet Union also has the world's largest deposits of natural gas and produces almost as much crude oil as the United States and Saudi Arabia combined.

If we give aid to the Soviet Union now, we are, in effect, ratifying the choices the communist ruling elite has made. We would
