At noon, CSPAN2 abruptly shifted from hearings regarding gays in the Military to Senate debate about the Clinton stimulus package. This was a

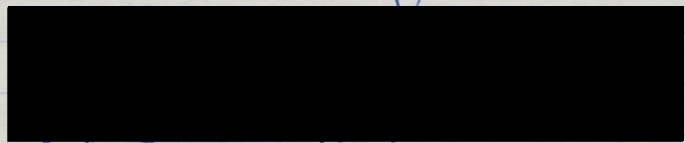
bad programming decision
