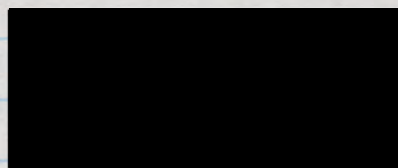
DEAR MR. LAMB

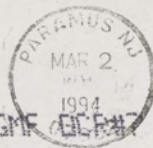
