

Gentlemen:


With this letter I would like to express my appreciation for your programming News 1 from Moscow. It is the best way to keep current on important developments in the CIS countries in these times of fast changes.

I usually plan to see the daily broadcasts the next morning at 7:20AM on C-SPAN 1, because News 1 is frequently preempted from its planned time in the evening and I often miss the first broadcasts on C-SPAN 1 and 2. Occasionally even this early morning broadcast does not occur, which is extremely disappointing to me. The latest example of this was yesterday, 14 April. I do hope you will consider making at least the morning slot a constant.

The second comment has to do with the banner you put at the bottom of the picture which covers up the information appearing in the News 1 broadcast. This seems to be your only program where a banner is visible continuously. I am sure there are viewers who can read the Russian a lot better than I would appreciate the absence of the banner from time to time during the transmission.
