Reference is made to our phone conversation on Monday, the 17th, when I enquired as to why we do not get C-SPAN2 in Apex. I mentioned that I was able to receive both C-SPAN and C-SPAN2 in Greensboro and I understand it is available in Raleigh itself--just a few miles from Apex.

You were very kind in listening to me and told me that your Cable Company is planning to acquire the additional capacity necessary to place Apex into the viewing spectrum for C-SPAN2 but that it could be a year before this is completed. I understand there are financial constraints on any business entity and I am sure it will be expensive to bring this about. I am pleased this expansion is being planned and I look forward to being able to get both C-SPAN and C-SPAN2.


