**C-SPAN COVERS DEBATES WITH VIEWER PARTICIPATION,
ARCHIVAL FOOTAGE, AND REPEAT PROGRAMMING**

Washington, D.C., October 6, 1992 -- As the general election campaign intensifies, C-SPAN announces plans for the upcoming Presidential and Vice Presidential debates. C-SPAN's signature debate coverage will include complete, uninterrupted, live coverage with no commentary or editorializing special archival debate footage courtesy of NBC; live open phone segments following each debate; and five re-airings on average of each debate within a 12-hour time period, allowing west coast viewers a prime time look at the event in its entirety.

The dates and locations of each debate have been confirmed and are as follows: 10/11, St. Louis, MO; 10/13 (Vice Presidential), Atlanta, GA; 10/15, Richmond, VA and 10/19, East Lansing, MI. The format for C-SPAN's debate coverage is as follows:

- * Presidential debate preview programming begins at 10:00 AM (ET), live, the day of the debate. This segment may include: host city preparations; Presidential Debate Commission history of debates; coaching and debate surrogates; and clips from former debates.
- * Archival footage at 1:00 PM (ET).
- * State race programming at 2:30 PM (ET).
- * Debate preview at 5:00 PM (ET).
- * *Live complete coverage of Presidential and Vice Presidential debates with no interruptions or commentary, beginning at 7:00 PM (ET) on October 11, 13 and 19, and 9:00 PM (ET) on October 15. Each debate is scheduled to be 90 minutes long.*
- * Live viewer call-in segments following each debate to allow viewers to voice their opinions of the candidates' performances.
