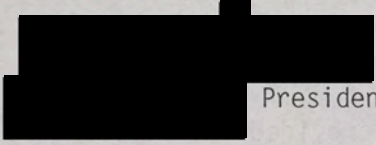

Enclosed please find the recent survey you sent out to me as a candidate for the US Senate from Ohio. But I must tell you that my attempt to run for Senate is only a way of seeking national media attention so that I can talk to the American people and let them know that someone who cares about them is a presidential candidate. My message is too crucial to get lost in the US Senate. It is the message to address the moral and economic decline of our country and I am the only one who is the right messenger.

As president I shall adopt the positions as indicated in the survey, but even more importantly I shall set out to put in place policies that will empower the people. You see, America to me is a place where EVERYONE SHOULD HAVE EQUAL OPPORTUNITY. To make this happen I would legislate a minimum wage of \$5 per hour plus a \$5,000 benefit package for every American worker; \$2,000 IRA, \$2,000 healthcare, and \$1,000 unemployment. This package would be 1/2 half for all part time workers. These policies would be started with employers with 7 or fewer workers; including owners, managers, supervisors and these benefits would replace Social Security, insurance, workers compensation and unemployment for these small businesses. The current Social Security is now in excess and if more is needed then employees who now pay Social Security on \$55,400 will be required to pay on whatever amount is necessary to make up the short fall. Over the next twenty to twenty-five years all businesses will be empowering their workers rather than government bureaucracies, insurance companies, and underfunded pension plans. **THIS WILL EMPOWER THE PEOPLE.** As business and government moves to this new empowerment less and less government will be needed to run the programs thus putting government workers into the private sector and increasing American productivity and thus a better product at a more competitive price.

The first \$10,000 of income would be free from ANY TAXES....provided the states were willing to go along with 15% of all earned and unearned income, including all foreign investment in their states and collect an additional 5% to send to Washington. This flat tax of 20% with the first \$10,000 exempt for everyone is fair. All deductions must be eliminated. After everyone pays 20% as their share of infrastructure, healthcare (catastrophic only), education, defense, and the environment they are free to do with the other 80% whatever they wish. The states would get rid of real estate taxes, sales taxes, inheritance taxes, personal property taxes and all taxes with the exception of a gas tax at the pump to go exclusively for infrastructure. As these taxes are abolished so too will much of the bureaucracies that run them. At some point in time I would expect that this 20% could be reduced even lower with everyone pulling their own weight.

To offset this new minimum wage and benefit package for business government workers shall earn no more than \$5-\$12.50 per hour plus the \$5,000 benefit package by the end of 1995 - this will give them three years to get their economic house in order and/or find private sector employment at a higher wage. With this decrease in government wages business will have a less tax burden and can use these funds, along with other tax savings at the state level to create more jobs; to clean up their workplace, to spend more on R&D. Anything except the consumption by government.

At the rate of \$5-\$12.50 plus \$5,000 government workers will be more in line with the rest of us \$10,400 plus \$5,000 up to \$31,000 plus \$5,000. This \$5,000 could be used to finance American housing and business. It shall not leave the country. With the first \$10,000 tax free and everyone making a decent wage and having benefits the American economy will be able to offer quality products and a fair price and have some to sell out of the country.



Business today pays huge salaries and benefits to a select few; which is fine if they feel they are worth it, but what I object to is that they want to deduct these huge salaries as a "business" expense and they want to pay these huge salaries on credit and again they want to deduct the interest as a "business" expense. It occurs to me that the main problem with our whole economy today is that everyone is going on credit because it is a tax deduction. Well to address this problem I shall limit salary deductions to a maximum of \$100,000 per employee and a deduction of only \$5,000 in benefits. You see what happens if they want big payroll deductions they must spread them around; and secondly they must have the money to pay for them because they shall no longer be able to deduct interest expense. Just like Congress gave the individual 5 years to loose the interest deductions so too shall business have ten years to get weaned off the credit life. Credit cost the American people trillions of dollars unnecessarily and inflates our economy as well as every good and service.

Today the higher echelon gets wealthy because they have tax "incentives/loopholes" that allow them to keep more of what they make and at the same time by not paying a fair wage they must sell their goods and services out of the country - again, to those that have. Such policies will always leave America and other countries with an underclass. THIS SHOULD NOT BE PERMITTED.

When it comes to taxes I would like to share something with you - when I purchase a twenty-four can of soda I buy it on sale for \$5 and pay .30¢ tax. When our poor buy this same twenty-four cans of soda it tends to be one can at a time at .60¢ plus .04¢ tax, thus they pay .96¢ in taxes. This is rampant in our economy which is why I oppose any taxes on the people except the flat 20% on income and a tax at the gas pump for infrastructure and a strong energy and environmental policy. In both cases of taxation people can keep their income down if they don't want to pay so much tax; or they can move closer to work and curtail their driving if they don't want to pay gas taxes. In essence, the people shall determine how much taxes they will pay - not legislation.

Also, I call you attention to the American dream of home ownership - what a laugh, the poor pay thirty years only to loose it for non payment of taxes. The average American can never be assured of their home so long as governments can arbitrarily raise real estate taxes when they need more money to keep their supporters from paying their fair share.

As president, I shall work for all the people. America wants change and not a glossing over of old failed policies that Bush and Clinton offer. When we level the playing field and make America that land of opportunity everyone will benefit. Even those who spend restless nights trying to keep what they confiscated from the sweat, blood, and tears of their fellow man.

The function of government is to make available to 100% of the American people a good education, clean air and water; a strong defense; housing and jobs. To pay for these services all Americans must share equally in the cost. No government is big enough to ride herd on 260,000,000 people and stay competitive in the world economy. Let Americans be the entrepreneurs we are. Let us keep .80¢ on the dollar and then get out of our way. Of course, we as a people must always remember that if we act like children we shall be treated like children. Do unto others as we would have them do unto us and America as well as the whole world will be a much safer and happier place.

What are the Facts? For forty-five years Israel has used the United States. I feel it is now time for them to get loan guarantees from Germany, their second largest trading partner. Israel would do well to make it possible for Jews to live in their own country through peaceful means if Israel is too small to absorb them.

Hello:

Between the period of February 18, 1992 and June 1, 1992 you were good enough to sign my petition for ballot access to run for the US Senate in November, 1992. The total signatures required by Mike Dewine and John Glenn is 1,000, yet for me as an INDEPENDENT the State requires 5,000. Robert Taft, secretary of state has certified 3,661 signatures out of approximately 5400 that I submitted. The purpose of this mailing is twofold; first to let you know that you may not be registered for the November election, and second to ask that you complete the enclosed post card and mail it back to me by return mail in the hopes that if 1,339 come back indicating that you were registered when you signed my petition or you had moved and were registered at another address at the time of the signing, or you had changed your name but you are a registered voter in Ohio, I shall send these to Robert Taft and ask that he certify me for the November ballot.

The reasons given for your signatures being invalid are as follows:

- 1) Not registered, or not registered at the address given
- 2) Printed name rather than sign the petition
- 3) The date was not filled in at the end of the line
- 4) The signature was illegible
- 5) The Board of Election did not mark some indicating why they were not counted
- 6) Some addresses were given as PO Box and were not valid
- 7) Some had incomplete addresses
- 8) Not registered under the name given
- 9) Some were signed on petitions in the wrong county
- 10) The circulator of the petition did not sign off properly

As many of you know I registered voters at the time of signing and I am not sure if these new registrations got in the system prior to the petition signatures being verified. For this reason I have a place on the post card where you are asked to check if you were registered by me.

I don't believe any state should legislatate in violation of the Constutition of the United States. The Fourteenth Amendment guarantees equal access. I don't believe 1,000 for Party candidates and 5,000 for non party candidates is an accurate interpretation of the Constitution. This fight is not for me alone - it is for all Americans who want to run for any public office. There should not be two standards.

If you were not registered at the time you signed my petition I ask that you complete your name and address and write across the card NOT REGISTERED. If you live in a mobile home park I would ask that you give the name and address of the Park as well as the actual number and street in the Park itself. Also, if you live in an apartment please include the name of the apartments and the apartment number.

It was very difficult to read some of the names and address so some may be incomplete and I do apologize but we did the best we could. Getting these postcards back quickly is very important so please take a moment today and drop it in the mail. I thank you again for signing my petition and for your response to this request.
