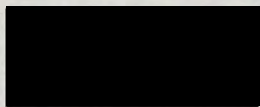
Dear Staff:

It seems our Coalition Command in the Gulf confrontation has leaned over backwards to avoid targeting facilities where "collateral" damage & possible civilian casualties could result!

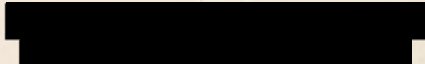
