WE HAD ALL BUT CEASED TO EVEN WATCH NEWS ON NBC, CBS AND ABC BECAUSE OF THEIR VERY LIBERAL, BIASED REPORTING.

OUR CABLE SYSTEM DOESN'T HAVE C-SPAN 2 AND TELLS US THEY WON'T UNTIL MORE CHANNELS ARE AVAILABLE(?).

THE MORE OPEN TV COVERAGE BEGINNING THE WEEK OF MARCH 21, 1995 IS MARVELOUS, BUT WE WOULD LIKE TO SEE MORE.

IF THE PUBLIC GALLERIES ARE OPEN IN BOTH CHAMBERS FOR CITIZEN VIEWING, THEN THE PROCEEDINGS SHOULD BE OPEN TO TV COVERAGE FOR THOSE WHO CANNOT BE IN D.C. IN PERSON, AND THE NETWORKS SHOULD BE ALLOWED TO USE THEIR OWN CAMERAS.

OUR LETTERS HAVE BEEN MAILED TO THE REPRESENTATIVES
AND SENATORS OF OUR DESIRE TO HAVE THE TV NETWORKS
USE THEIR OWN CAMERAS AND BE ALLOWED MORE OPEN
COVERAGE.
