WASHINGTON, D.C.-- For the third consecutive year, C-SPAN cable network will provide nationwide television coverage of the U.S. Conference of Mayors as more than 150 mayors gather in the nation's capital this month for their annual mid-winter meeting.

On January 23rd at 6:00 pm (EST), C-SPAN begins two day's coverage of the conference, including uncut cablecasts of plenary sessions and call-in programs with several of the nation's mayors. C-SPAN coverage allows cable viewers an insider's look at the mayors at work on public policy issues facing the cities.


As a member of the U.S. Conference of Mayors, you are probably aware that the conference's annual Washington meeting is just around the corner.
