Dear Sir,

As you know, several individuals, magazines, newspapers, news services, have filed suit against the President, the Secy of Defense, Chairman of the Joint Chiefs, the press Secy of the Defense department.

The longer your company waits to take action, the worse your credibility becomes. Your failure to join in this law suit compounds your organizational ineffectiveness. It becomes irrelevant what you do or say. What do you have to lose by supporting this law suit against the govt.?

The coverage so far does not meet the requirements for accurate reporting. The govt is reluctant to give you who, what, where, when, + if possible why.

I urge you to reexamine your present position + reestablish your position + credibility with the public by joining in this law suit.





P.S. You doing a great job but the govt. is still censoring too much. What don't you look into it further?
