I'm writing in regard to your Road to the Whitehouse programming. On Friday, January 10th, Road to the Whitehouse aired Dan Quayle's New Hampshire campaigning followed by a speech delivered to the Nashua, N.H. Rotary Club by former senator Paul Tsongas. Subsequently, an announcement stated that the programming would be shown again on Sun., Jan. 12th.

I just sat through 1 1/2 hours (5:30pm - 7:00pm) of Dan Quayle in New Hampshire, and another 1 1/2 hours (8:30pm - 10:00pm) of the earlier Quayle program repeated. Your imbalance in giving time equally to our main political parties seems like irresponsible broadcasting, let alone the fact that Dan Quayle's repetitious recitations were political

rhetoric, while Mr. Tsongas offered concrete facts and means to effect an economic turn-around in this country. When your announcement of the Sunday re-airing appeared, I immediately noted it so that my family could hear - and compare - Mr. Quayle and Mr. Tsongas. Thirty minutes of Mr. Tsongas speech said 1000 times more than your nearly 5 hours of Quayle.
