The problems of sound, permissions, etc. I leave to you.

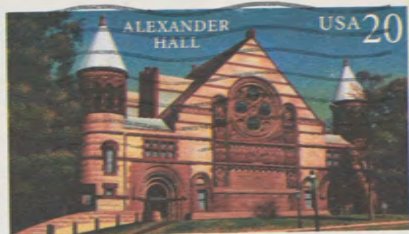
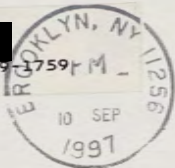
I know it would be a heavy problem.
