apart.

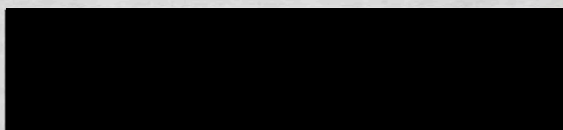
the people inside the beltway - politicians
