Do I have to have "ridiculous touch tone" to get through? I have tried to get through to you many times on as many different subject matters.

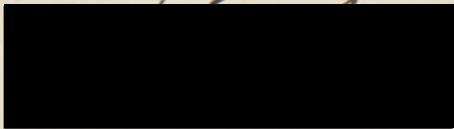
I do have one suggestion: when C-SPAN covers votes in the House of Representatives, while waiting for the tally to be completed, a description of the Bill before the House is produced in digest form at the bottom of the screen - good idea BUT often very misleading! How so?

Frequently it is not the actual Bill on which the vote is being taken, but rather an amendment which has been added to the Bill. The description of this amendment is not displayed: so a vote pro or con the amendment looks like the vote on the Bill, which could in fact be just the opposite. Is it possible to make this situation more clear for your viewers?

Unfortunately C-SPAN 2 is not aired in this area. Is this a matter of putting pressure on the local cable company?
