vote for or for which party — you get the same results. It's the reason that, campaign after campaign, promise after promise, you get a virtually identical government, whether the incumbents are Republicans or Democrats or conservatives or liberals.

It is the most important political truth in the post-war era, and the fate of United States depends upon how many American citizens understand that and do something about it.

Brown points out that politicians full of private greed and corrupt power, to rationalize their behavior, champion materialism and self-interest over moral responsibility and community. "To protect their power, they inject poisons into the body politic; appeals to fear and selfishness replace calls to hope and sacrifice."

That's another political truth.

The stupidest criticism of Brown is that he has in the past raised millions of dollars in special-interest money. Of course he has, and he talks about that. He knows the system, and he has rejected it.

People say that politicians are all the same. I'm telling you that Brown isn't. People are always saying, "What can I do?"
