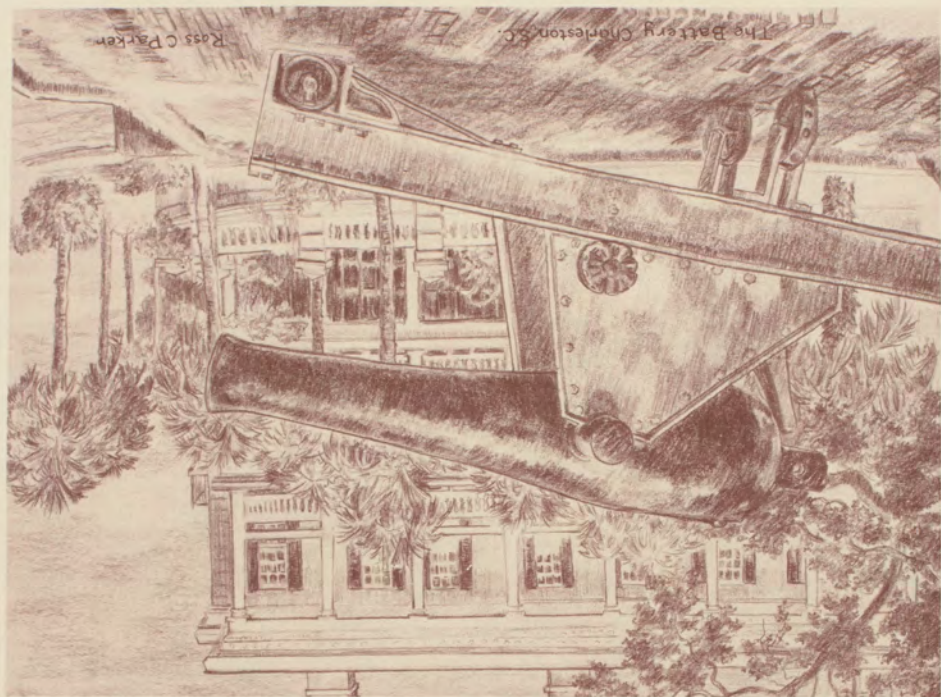

East Battery Street and South Battery Street

The Battery received its name from the fortifications that once guarded Charleston from the Spaniards, French and pirates. The Desasaur House, shown behind the cannon, was the last house built on the Battery before the Civil War. The porches with columns were added to catch the cool breezes and provide a wonderful view of the Atlantic. The cannon was salvaged from the sands of Sullivan Island by the heroic efforts of public-spirited men who wished to preserve some of the history of the conflict after the Civil War. This eleven-inch Dahlgren was from the wreck of the U.S.S. Keokuk.
