--Simulcasts from Around the Country as Primary Season Builds Momentum--

Washington, D.C., February 27, 1992 -- C-SPAN will be providing an innovative look at the Primary contests coming up across the country over the next two weeks. Local news simulcasts from Atlanta, Denver, Houston, and Tampa will bring C-SPAN's national audience a window to voters' choices in the Primaries.

In addition to campaign speeches, political advertisements, meet-and-greet events, and special programming for students, C-SPAN's Primary election coverage will include:

- * **Saturday, February 29 at 9:30-11:00 PM (ET):** C-SPAN will air the Democratic Presidential Debate from Denver, Colorado on the eve of the state Primary, sponsored by **KUSA TV (ABC affiliate)** and **The Rocky Mountain News**. At present, all Democratic candidates are confirmed except Sen. Tom Harkin (D-IA).
- * **Sunday, March 1 at 7:00 PM:** C-SPAN will air the presidential debate among Democratic candidates in its entirety from Atlanta, Georgia, sponsored by **WSB TV (ABC affiliate)**. Candidates confirmed for this debate are Gov. Bill Clinton (D-AK), fmr. Gov. Jerry Brown (D-CA), and fmr. Sen. Paul Tsongas (D-MA).
- * **Sunday, March 1, at 9:30 PM (ET) and 12:30 AM (ET):** "Road to the White House" will air the Democratic Presidential Debate which will be held in Maryland in its entirety on the eve of the state Primary. Scheduled to attend are the five Democratic contenders for the presidency.
- * **Tuesday, March 3, at 11:00 PM-1:00 AM (ET):** Evening election results of local Primaries will be simulcast from **Atlanta, Georgia WSB TV (ABC affiliate); Baltimore, Maryland WBAL TV (CBS affiliate);** and **Denver, Colorado KUSA (ABC affiliate)**. The

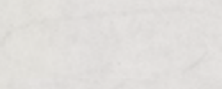
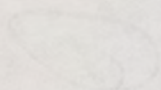
