As each speaker rose, you used to show his name, his party and his constituency. It was very interesting to know his constituency as it often had a bearing on his comments, so I am disappointed that you are now omitting this information. It seems that you **have chosen** instead to show that he is in the House of Commons. I do not think it is necessary to show this for each speaker, but just occasionally, as you used to do. Anyone watching the program already knows where it is coming from.

One problem with C-SPAN is that it is difficult to find out what programs are on. Neither our local newspaper nor the TV Guide list your channel. If you would show a listing of the day's programs at the end of each program, that would be very helpful. I'm always wondering if I'm missing anything else from Britain, or other items of interest, but obviously I can't watch television all day to find out.
