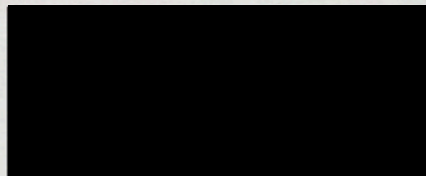
Plus the fact that the calls seem to have been orchestrated. I don't know by whom but Republicans, especially those charming Southern women with thick accents. Such naughty remarks!

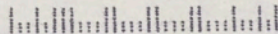


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
