REALIZE WE WERE DEALING WITH TWENTY FOOT TIDES. INSIDE THE ARTIFICIAL BREAKWATER WERE STEEL PREFABRICATED CAUSEWAYS CALLED MULLBERRYS WHICH WERE TOWED ACROSS THE CHANNEL. MILLIONS OF TONS OF SUPPLIES WENT ACROSS THIS JURY RIG. TO GET

FUEL ACROSS IN LARGE QUANTITIES UNDERGROUND PLASTIC PIPES WERE USED ACROSS THE CHANNEL. THESE WERE CALLED PLUTOS.
