Thank you for interviewing Dr. Alex Dragnich on your "Booknotes" program on March 7, 1993 on the subject of his latest book, Serbs & Croats.

You are one of the few media personalities devoid of malice and overt hostility against Serbian people. This is obvious to me from your manner of questioning, your genuine intent to hear all sides of the argument, and absence of sarcasm, goading typical of many of your colleagues.

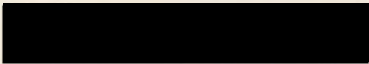

I urge you to give TRUTH one more chance on your "Booknotes" or whatever other program you think would serve the purpose best.

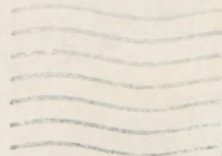
