PPS: Love the tone of the Susan B Anthony & the Call-ins on this segment are so different.

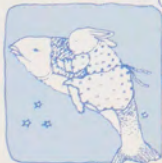

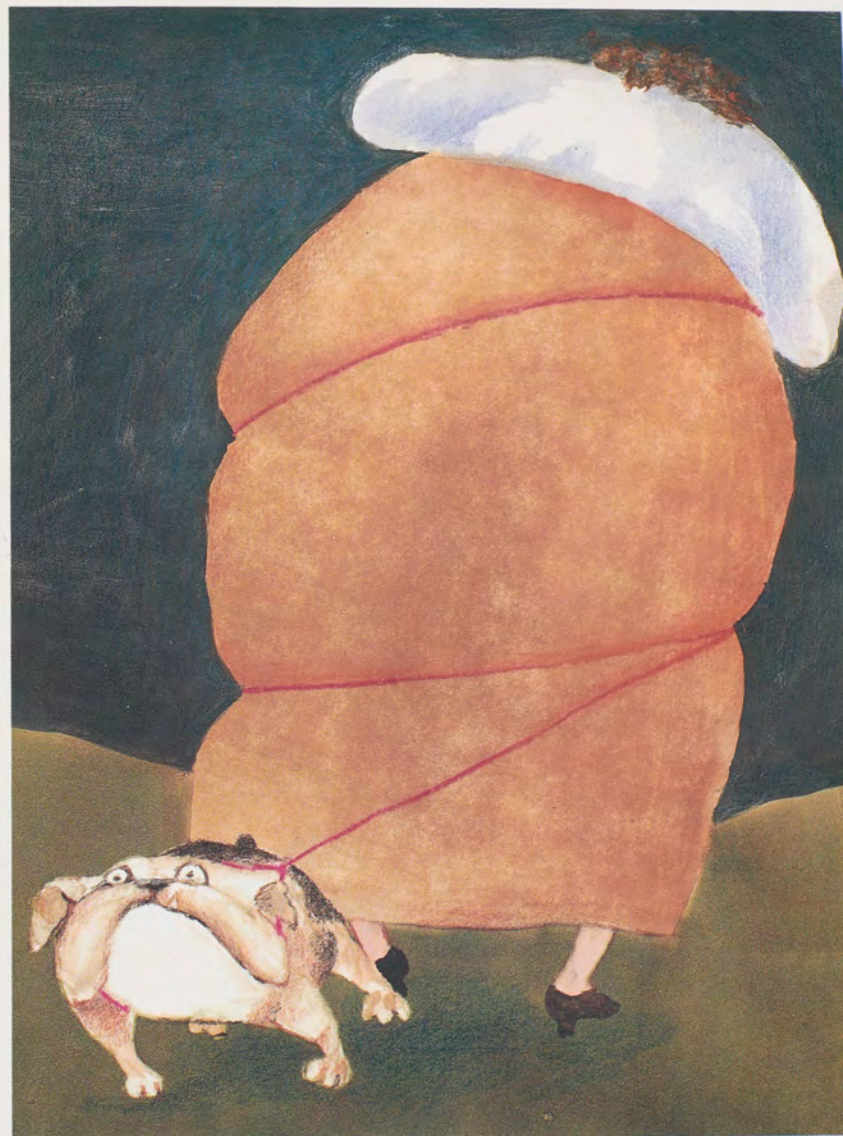
