Dear Brian:

I am very thankful for C-SPAN giving us a glimpse of how our government actually operates, and I watch your morning roundtables with various Congressmen, Senators, and journalists religiously (you come on at 5:00, roughly, out here.)

I wanted to inform you, and also your fellow hosts, that the problem of illegal immigration and excessive third world legal immigration into our country is a hot issue out here in Southern California and all of the Southwestern United States, and I've yet to hear any real discussion of it in the morning, except for a few call-ins who mention it.

I am asking you to maybe line up Don Stein of the Federation for American Immigration Reform, right there in Washington, and possibly Glenn Spencer of the Voices of Citizens Together, (who was featured on a recent '48 Hours' Television program) for an honest, factual discussion on this problem of the violation of the sovereignty of the United States. I would guarantee you that this

show would be one of your most volatile ever as far as call-ins. I don't think middle + Northeastern America realize the impact that this situation is having on their country, and I really do believe you and your fellow hosts should begin seriously addressing it. After all, our California representatives are seeking billions of Federal dollars to defray the costs of services to these folks, mostly from Mexico, and that means that everyone from California to Maine is going to cover this cost.

We are also looking at a situation where more people are coming over than can possibly be assimilated or find work, and as a result, pockets of 'foreign nations' are developing in our own country, at the expense of Citizen taxpayers.
