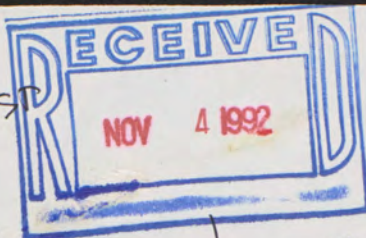

Speculating on Clinton Cabinet

Next to electing Bill Clinton, no issue grips the Democratic power elite more than whom he will name to fill top national security posts.

The Arkansas governor will come to this task, if elected, with one plus and some problems. The plus is he can lean on Al Gore, who has considerable experience and standing in this field, and his key aide, Leon Fuerth.

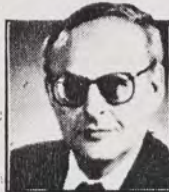
A minus is that Clinton's credentials here are suspect. He probably would feel the need to turn to establishment figures to reassure an anxious nation. Even John Kennedy, who had foreign experience, reached out for comforting names like Douglas Dillon for Treasury and Dean Rusk for the State Department. (Note: JFK also threw in some surprises like Bob McNamara for Defense.)

But there is no longer much of an establishment, particularly for Democrats. They have controlled the executive branch, where reputations are made, for only 4 of the last 24 years. So, Clinton appointees would not be as well known and reassuring as the Kennedy Cabinet.

Also, Clinton says he wants to broaden the definition of national security to include, if not center on, matters like global economic policy and the environment. Yet, the more he would depend on relatively known Democrats and moderate Republicans, the less his government would reflect this new priority.

With these considerations in mind, I telephoned two dozen people who probably would be consulted by a Clinton transition team, and asked for names and comments. The following are the lucky winners (i.e., those who may now indulge in new and perhaps illusory hope).

Secretary of State: Warren

Christopher, number two in the Carter State Department (comforting and very cautious); Lee Hamilton, slated as the next chairman of the House Foreign Affairs Committee (sound on policy, no proven executive ability), and Tom Pickering, a former U.N. ambassador and career diplomat (an established pro).

Secretary of Defense: Les Aspin, chairman of the House Armed Services Committee (experienced and expert, unloved by the military); Sam Nunn, chairman of the Senate Armed Services Committee (all of Aspin's pluses and good military ties, but quirky and perhaps too conservative), and Gen. Colin Powell, chairman of the Joint Chiefs (very able, but of uncertain party loyalties).

National Security Adviser: Tony Lake, a Carter State Department policy planning chief and now a top Clinton aide (all-around first class, pragmatic, but not well known); Peter Tarnoff, president of the Council on Foreign Relations (former career diplomat and formidable doer); Richard Holbrooke, senior Carter State Department official (brilliant on blending policy and politics, controversial), and Bernard (Mick) Trainor, a former Marine general, now at Harvard (good head, but narrow background).

CIA: Dave McCurdy, chairman of the House intelligence panel (close to

Clinton, knowledgeable, unproven executive skills); Bob Inman, retired admiral and former number two at the agency (a well-connected pro, unclear political loyalties), and David Aaron, top Carter NSC official (extraordinarily able and controversial).

Secretary of the Treasury: Pete Peterson, Nixon commerce secretary, now an investment banker (politically savvy, intellectual powerhouse, reassuring); Felix Rohatyn, investment banker (terrific ideas, highly respected, little government experience), and Bob Rubin, banker (great manager, short on policy background).

Other names came up frequently for key jobs. Winston Lord and Sam Lewis, both former career diplomats, received rave reviews for U.N. ambassador. Jessica Tuchman Mathews, a Carter NSC aide, was often cited glowingly for the Environmental Protection Agency and for the Department of Energy. Richard Gardner, a lawyer and teacher, was cited favorably for his exceptional knowledge of "new issues."

High praise for international economic positions went to economists Fred Bergsten, Bob Hormats, and Joan Spero (all smart, experienced policy hands) and Roger Altman, a deft banker. John Sculley of Apple Computer was suggested as someone who could handle converting defense jobs. Jim Jones, head of the American Stock Exchange and a former congressman, got high marks for many posts, including budget director.

More to come. Don't call; I'm going on vacation.

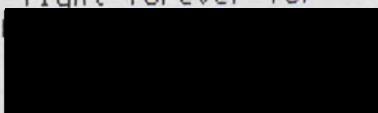
1. Re-Read Al Smith's 1936 talk: Betrayal of the Democratic Party.

Dear Ross,

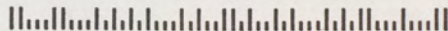
