TIPS

H.U.G. a child
for better results

Children do better in school if they receive a half-hour H.U.G. each day — help, understanding and guidance with academics from a parent or another adult who cares about the child.

Some ideas from the state Department of Education for ways to spend that half-hour:

- While making a meal, use recipes to reinforce math and reading. Have your child read the recipe out loud, measure the ingredients and figure out how to double the meal or cut it in half.

- Use mealtime to talk about current events and news stories. After dinner, get out a map or globe and locate the places you talked about.

- Play a "word a day" game with your child. Each of you select a word from the dictionary, then challenge each other to use it in conversation.

- Play a strategy game such as Scrabble, bingo, Monopoly or dominos to increase reading, math and reasoning skills.

- Pick a sports team and keep a running total of wins and losses for an entire season.

- Read to a young child every day. Have older children read aloud daily. Make sure children of all ages understand what they are reading and hearing by asking them questions.

- Limit after-school activities and jobs that interfere with homework.

- Praise your child's efforts. Display projects around the house. As the school year

progresses, point out the progress your child has made.
