Dear President Clinton =

IMPEACHMENT

As you know, from May 9th through May 20th, in addition to Haiti, I sent you a series of private FAX messages with top secret plans to immediately stop the terrible civil wars in Rwanda, Yemen, Angola, Bosnia and elsewhere—plans that would not require the introduction of a single United States combatant in any of these countries. I gave you my military credentials—or I should say some of them—and told you I was confident my plans would work.

Despite this, you have totally ignored my messages. As a result the fighting and killing, which could have been stopped, continues unabated in all these countries. It was reported this morning that in Rwanda alone more than a half million men, women and children have been butchered by cowardly killers on both the government and rebel sides—so far.

Although you have no plans at all to stop the slaughter in these countries, you refuse even to acknowledge my plans much less put them into effect. Your behavior is beyond belief. What kind of men are you?

I consider your failure to execute my plans to be criminal neglect of duty and grounds for your immediate impeachment as President of the United States.
