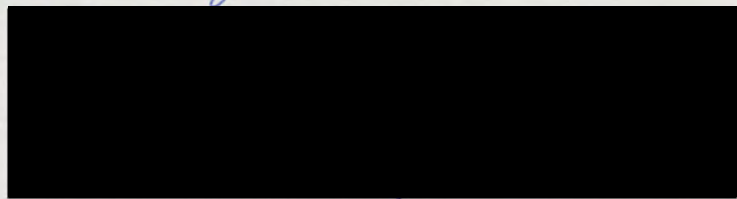
That jack ass from N.Y city was not the redeeming program I had
