

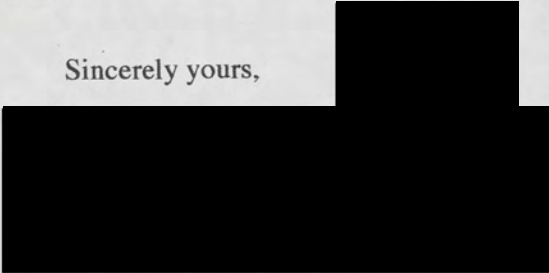

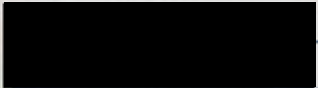

Every Tuesday through Saturday morning I rely on the Russian Evening News from Moscow for most of my news, because I travel to that part of the world. Lately I have been rather perturbed at the fact that your other programs that run before 7:20 am Eastern time run late into the time slot for the Moscow Evening News and then you cut important information off when the Moscow Evening News runs past 8:00 am Eastern time. What infuriates me even more is the fact that this week the Moscow Evening News has been canceled twice. I would greatly appreciate if you would show the Moscow Evening News in its entirety and not let anything cut into its timeslot, especially since most of those programs are prerecorded anyway. If this is becoming a habit, and if I can not rely on The Moscow Evening News to be shown at 7:20 am Eastern time, I may as well save more money by buying a satellite dish capable of picking up signals from Moscow than paying for Cable. The only reason I watch Cable is to watch C-SPAN at 7:20 am to watch the Moscow Evening News. I hope to have a response and I hope that you won't disappoint a reliable viewer of your network.
