I would like to express for [redacted] the Political Science Professor at Mary Washington College in Fredericksburg, Va. my disappointment at his answer to a caller in on the subject of the well-known and long-standing history of Israel's civil rights abuses and terrorist tactics.

That he should immediately equate the caller's statement with "anti-Semitism" calls into question his capabilities in academic studies in the search for truth. Bionism has to be separated from Judaism as many of our Jewish friends would agree.

A very significant little book "What Price Israel" by Alfred Pilienthal in the 1950's was

suppressed by the Zionists, to the impoverishment of
our understanding. It is all a very complex
situation which is not helped by anyone, academic
