Ladies and Gentlemen:

I can never get through on your telephone lines re: Washington Journal.

Enclosed is a letter that I forwarded to all 100 Senators and I do not know how the subject matter was received, and I have not heard reference to any of the matters discussed on any of the numerous programs pertaining to the President's trial.

If you consider these questions interesting would you ask your appropriate guest(s) to comment on the questions:

1. Concerning PRECEDENT that will be established as a result of this trial, do you think the issue of TRUSTWORTHINESS IN GOVERNMENT will be affected?

(my commentary- that in future similar situations The Constitution of the United States will be interpreted as more liberal toward LYING, MISLEADING, etc., by Presidents and other members of government, if the President is exonerated? Will the Constitution be strengthened by conviction?)

2. Concerning the interpretation of HIGH CRIMES by a President of the United States considering the power, prestige, and influence of the Presidency. Is the effect of bad behavior by the President, by example, of lying adultery, etc., a higher crime if done by the President than if it were done by ordinary citizenry?

(my commentary- because the President is the leader of the world and the Commander in Chief of the most powerful nation in the world, he should be above reproach.)

My concern is that if the President is excused and slapped on the wrist with censure, etc., that the level of morality of our American culture will be lowered. For instance, our Boy Scout laws call for "Trustworthy, Loyal, etc., The President lies and commits adultery. Our Girl Scouts, youth organizations, schools, all prescribe to high moral behavior, but the President's behavior does not support that.

Our four Military Academies prescribe to the "Honor System" as do VMI and various colleges, and schools. How will they reconcile the President's behavior?

Our Courts and Judiciary System are dependent upon the oath

to tell the truth, the whole truth, nothing but the truth.

The Internal Revenue Service is dependent on honest voluntary tax reporting.

Even though humans weaken and commit "Crimes and Misdemeanors", the Presidency is obliged to set higher moral standards for citizens, and especially for our young people.

The Presidency is greater than one man. Mr. Clinton should be an expendable soldier and resign the office. We have highly competent executives in all three branches of government to manage the affairs of the United States.

Dear Senator,

A vote on your part to CONFIRM impeachment will lift morality in national life, and enhance the dignity of the United States at home and abroad.
