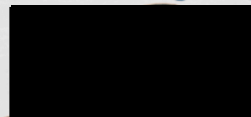


Though nature must do the occasional hurricane, flood, earthquake, and tremors of all sorts, the given grace of special talent in each of us makes this a wonderful world.
