C-SPAN OFFERS LIVE COVERAGE OF PRESIDENT'S TOWN MEETING

Washington, D.C., May 13, 1993 -- On Monday, May 17, from 11:00PM - 12:00 midnight (ET)/8:00-9:00 PM (PT), C-SPAN will simulcast President Clinton's town meeting *live* from San Diego, California, courtesy of KGTV-TV an ABC affiliate.

President Clinton will answer questions from a live studio audience ranging from foreign policy to the economy, and other major domestic issues. This is the second time a local television station has sponsored a town meeting with the president since he took office in January. The first time was in Detroit, Michigan, and was also carried live on C-SPAN.

C-SPAN is available in 59.3 million households nationwide and around the world via satellite. C-SPAN is entirely funded by America's cable television companies as a public service.
