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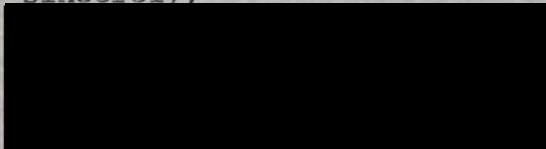

**R**ight now, the American Center for Law and Justice is operating at maximum capacity — recently logging in 10 major court appearances in an 8-week period! With more than 200 cases on file, we are actively negotiating to establish offices in major cities and regions — and the need for new facilities is greater than ever. Here are just a few examples of ways we're battling for the rights of Christians:

- We successfully defended a 57-year-old grandmother in San Antonio, Texas, who was handcuffed, strip-searched and thrown in an unheated jail cell for passing out religious tracts on the public roadway across from a high school. All charges were dropped, and we are looking into filing a suit to seek damages for the violation of her civil rights.
- As students plan to gather around their school flag poles this fall to pray, we have sent over 14,000 letters to every

school district in the nation informing them of the consequences if they interfere with their rights.

• **Bray v. Alexandria Women's Health Clinic** — Jay will be rearguing this case before the Supreme Court in October 1992, protesting the use of the Ku Klux Klan Act of 1871 to prohibit Operation Rescue sit-in activities. The outcome will have a major impact in the fight against abortion.

• The most important case this year regarding Christians' rights to evangelize involves Stone Mountain Park in Georgia. Shortly after it was announced as one of the primary sites

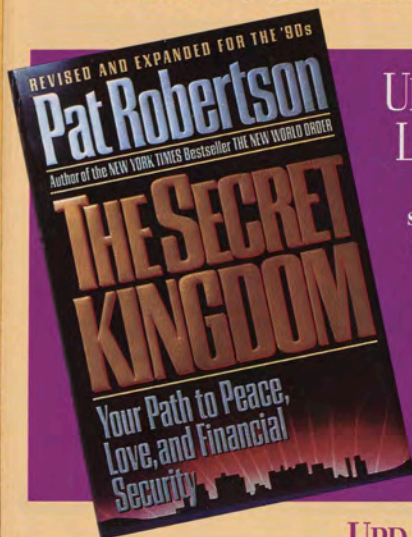
for the 1996 Summer Olympics, the park instituted a ban on the distribution of religious literature. We have already obtained a permanent injunction blocking the enforcement of this ban, and we will be

arguing this case before the Georgia Supreme Court.

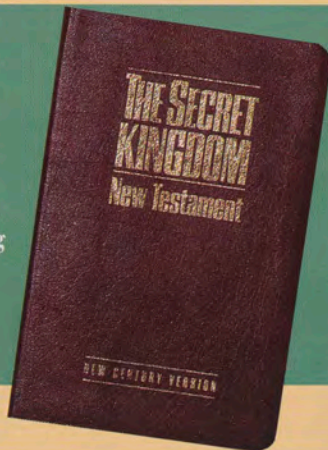
