Leave Social Security alone

If a person buys a new car for \$20,000 and pays \$500 for insurance, and his car is destroyed, the insurance pays him \$20,000 — which is \$19,500 more than he paid into the insurance fund. Will the person have to pay income tax on the \$19,500?

In order for the insurance to pay \$19,500 more than it received from that person, other people have to pay into the insurance fund — like people have to pay into the Social Security

fund before they can be paid from it.

The Clinton administration is passing a law to make senior citizens who are too old to work pay income tax on up to 85 percent of the amount they draw from the Social Security fund. Senior citizens receive payments from the Social Security fund according to the amount that they and their employer paid into the fund.

As most people know, there is a law that *makes* a person and his em-

ployer pay into the Social Security fund.

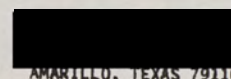
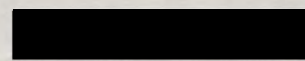
