I now rarely see black panelists for any discussion, whether it be the Journalists' Roundtable, the Close-Up with high school kids, or any other discussion group.

Because public policy has such an overwhelming impact on African Americans, and because you are offering a public service, I believe you should have more African Americans on your network. I hope you will make an effort to move your network back in the direction of fairness and inclusion. If C-SPAN is truly open to the public, then let's see the various elements of the public represented justly as we discuss the critical issues facing this nation.
