other shows that give an on balance of the

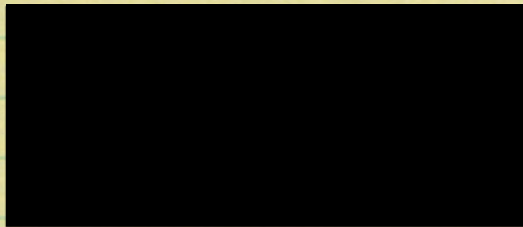
subject matter. Certainly you must know that something is wrong with your call-ins. Your reporter - it was your choice.
