I know a conservative African-American female. (Rather, I have met her in print.) I take it that you do not rule out the value of a fair hearing for citizens like Elizabeth Wright, who articulates a different vision for African-American success than white or black liberals preach.

I have confidence that you will contribute to the importance of free and vigorous public debate and accept this challenge to make contact with Ms. Wright. Here's one suggestion: an all-volunteer registry of law-abiding Texans who are chosen entirely at random; the race or gender of the potential juror should be unknown to the attorneys on both sides. Every registered volunteer for jury duty should be required to read the U.S. Constitution, and affirm under oath to be as fair and impartial as possible. 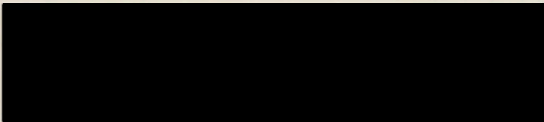
