I find it very irritating when I hear the names of persons or names of cities misprono mode. I assume that you would feel the same way if you happen to be in Europe and hear the word NEW YORK with the pronounce, as in BED instead of as N (YOU) YORK.

A person whose job is to speak to millions of people should, ask someone if not sure. There are millions of Europeans in this country. If you need any help in connection with FRENCH, SPANISH, ITALIAN GERMAN RUSSIAN CROATIAN or SLOVAK you may ask me and I will not charge anything for it.
