that is unnecessary ~~and~~



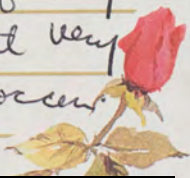


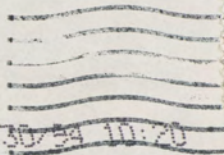
Media people should be
